Gilbert Poillerat is a French designer and architect. He was born in Beauce-Sologne in 1902 and studied at the École Boulle in Paris. He worked for the architect Le Corbusier and the designer Marcel Breuer. He is known for his modernist furniture and lighting designs. He died in 1988. He was a member of the Société des Artistes Décorateurs and the Académie des Beaux-Arts. He was also a member of the Académie de l'Architecture.
